


Remove & Replace Old Thermostat



Remove the cover of the old thermostat. If it does not come off easily check for screws.



Loosen the screws holding the thermostat base or subbase to the wall, and lift away.










Keep the old thermostat for reference purposes, until your new thermostat is functioning properly.


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










